Mayor Anthony opened the meeting for a public hearing:


Stan Graham of 201 Allegro shared that he is not quite sure what is going on. He understands there are some disagreements with Robert's contract. He is attending to support Robert and ask the Council to be transparent in their actions. If it leads to a serious disagreement of sorts, to be conscious of both sides. Also recommended, if it goes further down the road, Council hire a mediator or arbitrator. Then if it does go even further down the road where Robert might leave the city, let the current contract be the basis of the agreement. The City writes the check and that be the end of it.

Dave Claunch of 305 McConnell doesn't understand why anyone is here. He doesn't understand what is going on. It has been on the agenda three to four times and all he knows is that Council is considering amending Robert's contract. Maybe this can happen real smooth and both parties move on down the road. He has complete support that Council has the right to change any aspect of how this government works. Robert is one of the most talented, skilled, and professional people that he has every worked with. He is not saying Robert is perfect, if there have been any performance issues. Mr. Claunch doesn't think that any of it rises to the merits to change the contract. The contract was negotiated at a very contentious time for the city. There were six people who never agreed about anything but came together to hire Robert. He took the job because of the contract that was offered to him. This is Robert's livelihood. He hopes that Council is respectful when going through this process. There are a lot of people that respect and like Robert so it must be some compelling reasons why Council would want to change his agreement. He also asked Council to be transparent during this process.
