## Public Safety Report June, 2016

### **Investigations**

In June, Detective Torres was assigned 31 new cases. 25 cases were closed in June and 6 are carrying over into July. Detective Torres currently has 24 open cases that she is investigating.

### **Training**

Department personnel completed 92 hours of training including courses in "Incident Command", "CJIS Security", "Bleeding Control for the Injured", "Patrol Rifle Training", and "SFST Refresher".

### **Personnel**

We had one officer sworn in on June 8<sup>th</sup> and another one sworn in on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Even though they will be in training for up to four months, this is a big boost to our Department's manpower.

### **Statistical Highlights**

During the month of June, there were five (5) reported Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) part 1 offenses, compared with eight (8) for the month of May and seven (7) during the month of June last year. Officers made two (2) arrests during the month, including Driving While Intoxicated (1) and one (1) warrant arrest out of Denton County.

Officers responded to 21 Traffic Collisions, compared to 25 for May. Our most common crash locations requiring police reports this year are 5600 Bee Cave Road with 11 collisions followed by 3300 and 4600 Bee Cave Rd with 4 crash reports each.

In June, our officers made 116 traffic stops, issuing 88 citations (75.8%) resulting in 101 violations, and 40 warnings (34.4%). Of the citations that were issued, 48 (54.5%) were for speeding.

During June, 2016, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 274 calls for service compared to 283 for May. This resulted in 26 reports being generated. Officers also conducted 594 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 469 for May.

### **Improvements**

During the month of June, our updated Close Patrol guidelines were put on the City website along with a Close Patrol form that can be electronically submitted to the Police Department.

We also started posting the monthly Public Safety Report on the website and will update the information each month.
