## Public Safety Report May 2019

### **Statistical Highlights**

During the month of May, there were nine reported NIBRS part 1 offenses, compared with four for the month of April and five during the month of May last year. Officers made eight in-custody or field release arrest in May for Fail to Identify as Fugitive, Driving While License Invalid, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Minor in Possession of Alcohol.

Officers responded to 23 Traffic Crashes, compared to 21 for April, and this resulted in six crash reports being created. Six crashes this month occurred on Bee Cave Road.

In May, our officers made 386 traffic stops, resulting in 268 violations (69%), and 330 warnings (85%). Of the violations that were cited, 156 (40%) were for speeding, including 41 for speeding in a school zone. Officers also wrote five citations for failing to stop or remain stopped for a school bus. In the 15 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 21 violations and 67 warnings.

During May, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 204 calls for service, compared to 206 calls for service in April. During the month, 52 reports were generated. Officers also conducted 78 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 61 for April.

### **Investigations**

In May, Detective Torres was assigned 11 new cases. Detective Torres currently has 36 open cases that she is investigating.

### **Training**

Officers completed 36 hours of training, including classes in "Common Threats", "Social Engineering" and "Security Awareness".
