

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-008

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR THE CONDUCT AND THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Council (the “City Council”) of the City of West Lake Hills, Texas (the “City”) is authorized and has determined to call an election to submit propositions to voters in the City to determine whether the City Council shall be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the amounts and for the purposes hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the City will enter into one or more Election Agreements (collectively, the “Election Agreement”) with Travis County, Texas (the “County”), by and through the county election officer (the “Administrator”), and possibly other political subdivisions, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas (the “State”) and applicable federal law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and declares that the meeting at which this Ordinance is considered is open to the public, and that the public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given, as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Date; Propositions. An election (the “Election”) shall be held for and within the City on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 (“Election Day”), in accordance with the Texas Election Code (the “Code”) and other applicable law. At the Election, the following propositions (the “Propositions”) shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City in accordance with law:

CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS - PROPOSITION A

Shall the City Council of the City of West Lake Hills, Texas (the “City”) be authorized to issue bonds, in one or more series, in a principal amount not to exceed \$13,200,000 maturing serially or otherwise over a period of years (not to exceed the lesser of 40 years or the maximum prescribed by law) and bearing interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise), not to exceed the respective limits prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance, and to levy, impose

and pledge a tax upon all taxable property in the City sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of the bonds as they mature, for the purpose of making permanent public improvements as follows: constructing, acquiring, improving, renovating, expanding and developing a new City Hall and Police Building and related infrastructure?

CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS - PROPOSITION B

Shall the City Council of the City of West Lake Hills, Texas (the “City”) be authorized to issue bonds, in one or more series, in a principal amount not to exceed \$11,800,000 maturing serially or otherwise over a period of years (not to exceed the lesser of 40 years or the maximum prescribed by law) and bearing interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise), not to exceed the respective limits prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance, and to levy, impose and pledge a tax upon all taxable property in the City sufficient to pay the interest on the bonds, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of the bonds as they mature, for the purpose of making permanent public improvements, to wit: constructing, improving, renovating, extending, expanding and developing streets, roads and related drainage improvements, including traffic signalization, lighting, sidewalks, soundwalls and landscaping, and acquiring right-of-way related thereto, with respect to Camp Craft Road, Laurel Valley Road, Redbud Trail, Westlake Drive, Yaupon Valley Road and Terrace Mountain Drive?

Section 3. Official Ballots. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with and conform to the requirements of the Code so as to permit the electors to vote “FOR” or “AGAINST” the aforesaid Propositions which shall be set forth on the ballots substantially in the following form:

CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS - PROPOSITION B

- FOR) The issuance of bonds in the amount of \$11,800,000 and the
-) imposition of taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and
-) interest on the bonds for street and drainage improvements
-) to Camp Craft Road, Laurel Valley Road, Redbud Trail,
-) Westlake Drive, Yaupon Valley Road and Terrace
- AGAINST) Mountain Drive.

Section 4. Persons Qualified to Vote. All resident, qualified electors of the City shall be eligible to vote at the Election.

Section 5. Election Precincts, Voting Locations and Voting Hours on Election Day. Except as otherwise provided herein, the boundaries and territories of the County election precincts that are wholly or partially within the territorial boundaries of the City are hereby designated as the voting precincts of the City for the Election and the precinct numbers for the City's election precincts shall be the corresponding County precinct number of each precinct. The Election Day polling places shall be as shown in Exhibit A to this Ordinance. Exhibit A shall be modified to reflect any alterations or changes in or additions to polling places required to conform to the Code or the Election Agreement or as directed by the Administrator.

On Election Day the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 6. Early Voting Locations, Dates and Times. Early voting by personal appearance for all election precincts shall be held at the locations, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit B, or at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the Administrator. Exhibit B shall be modified to reflect any alterations or changes in or additions to early voting polling places or times for early voting required to conform to the Code or the Election Agreement or as directed by the Administrator.

The Administrator is hereby designated as the Early Voting Clerk. The Administrator's contact information/delivery addresses for applications for ballots to be voted by mail and other matters related to the Election is as follows:

Section 7. Appointment of Election Officers. Prior to the Election Day, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the Election will be appointed by the Administrator, and the election judges and alternate judges may be changed and the polling places may be combined for some precincts, pursuant to decisions of the Administrator. The Administrator shall also be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots cast in such election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station. The City Council hereby authorizes each of the Mayor, City Administrator, Finance Officer, City Secretary and/or any of their designees (collectively, the "Authorized Representatives") to appoint any such other officials not designated herein or appointed by the Administrator as are necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in accordance with the Code.

Section 8. Notice of Election. Notice of the Election shall be given in the manner required by the Code and other applicable law. The City's website may be accessed at the following address: <https://www.westlakehills.org/>. To the extent required by law, notice of the Election shall include such address.

Section 9. Bilingual Election Materials. All notices, instructions, and ballots pertaining to the Election shall be furnished to voters in both English and Spanish and persons capable of acting as translators in both English and Spanish shall be made available to assist Spanish language speaking voters in understanding and participating in the election process.

Section 10. Conduct of Election. The Election shall be conducted by election officers, including the precinct judges and alternate judges or clerks appointed by the Administrator or the Authorized Representatives, in accordance with the Election Agreements, the Code and the Constitution and laws of the State and the United States of America. The Authorized Representatives are authorized to enter into, execute and deliver one or more Election Agreements, in accordance with applicable provisions of the Code. The terms and provisions of each Election Agreement are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance. To the extent of any conflict between this Ordinance and an Election Agreement, the terms and provisions of the Election Agreement shall prevail, and the Authorized Representatives are authorized to make such corrections, changes, revisions and modifications to this Ordinance, including the exhibits hereto, as are deemed necessary or appropriate to conform to the Election Agreement, to comply with applicable State and federal law and to carry out the intent of the City Council, as evidenced by this Ordinance. The Administrator shall be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots cast in the Election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station.

Section 11. Necessary Actions. The Mayor and City Council of the City, in consultation with the City's attorney and bond counsel are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of the Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act in carrying out and conducting the Election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.

Section 12. Mandatory Disclosure of Information.

(a) Pursuant to Section 3.009, Texas Election Code: (i) the proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 3 of this Ordinance, (ii) the purposes for which the bonds are to be authorized are set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance, (iii) the principal amount of bonds to be authorized is set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance, (iv) if the issuance of bonds is authorized by voters, taxes sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the costs of any credit agreements may be imposed, as set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance, (v) bonds authorized pursuant to this Ordinance may be issued to mature over a specified number of years not to exceed the lesser of 40 years or the maximum number of years authorized by law and bearing interest at the rate or rates (not to exceed 15%), as authorized by law and determined by the City Council, (vi) as of the date of the adoption of this Ordinance, the aggregate amount of outstanding principal of the City's debt obligations is \$0.00, and the aggregate amount of outstanding interest on the City's debt obligations is \$0.00 and (vii) the City's ad valorem debt service tax rate as of the date of adoption of this Ordinance is \$0.00 per \$100 of taxable property. The City's Wastewater System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2019 are not secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes and are, therefore, excluded

from the aggregate amount of outstanding principal and interest on the City's debt obligations described in this paragraph.

(b) Based upon market conditions as of the date of this Ordinance, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 3.00%. Such estimated maximum interest rate is provided as a matter of information but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds, or any series thereof, may be sold. In addition, the estimate contained in this subsection (b) is (i) based on certain assumptions (including assumptions concerning prevailing market and economic conditions at the time(s) of issuance of the bonds) and derived from projections obtained from the City's financial advisor, (ii) subject to change to the extent that actual facts, circumstances and conditions prevailing at the time that the bonds are issued differ from such assumptions and projections, (iii) provided solely in satisfaction of the requirements of Section 3.009, Texas Election Code, and for no other purpose, without any assurance that such projections will be realized, and (iv) not intended to give rise to a contract with voters or limit the authority of the City Council to issue bonds in accordance with the Propositions submitted by this Ordinance.

Section 13. Severability. If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word, or provision of this Ordinance, for it is the definite intent of the City Council that every section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, work, or provision hereof be given full force and effect for its purpose.

Section 14. Effective Date. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1201.028, Texas Government Code, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
