Public Safety Report April, 2018

Investigations

In April, Detective Torres was assigned 13 new cases. Of these 13 cases, seven of them were closed or suspended in April – six are carrying over into May. Detective Torres currently has eight open cases that she is investigating.

Training

Officers completed 76 hours of training, including classes in “Supervisors Role in the Use of Force”, “Courtroom Security Officer”, “Taser Recertification”, “Search Warrants in Major Case Investigations”, and “Body Worn Cameras”.

Statistical Highlights

During the month of April, there were eight reported NIBRS part 1 offenses, compared with four for the month of March and five during the month of April last year. Officers made seven arrests in April - one for Possession of a Prohibited Weapon, two for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, one for Public Intoxication, one for Driving with an Invalid License, and two for Warrants.

Officers responded to 18 Traffic Crashes, compared to 21 for March, and this resulted in seven crash reports being created. Our most common crash location this month requiring a police report was 4200 Bee Cave Road, with four of our seven crashes happening at this location.

In April, our officers made 268 traffic stops, issuing 236 citations (88.0%) resulting in 264 violations, and 154 warnings (57.4%). Of the violations that were cited, 133 (50.3%) were for speeding, and 24 of these 133 speeding violations were for speeding in a school zone. In addition, we issued five citations for failure to stop or remain stopped for a school bus. In the 15 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 65 violations and 47 warnings, including 19 violations and 4 warnings on Ridgewood.

During April, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 186 calls for service, compared to 236 calls for service in March. During the month, 56 reports were generated. Officers also conducted 46 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 27 for March.
